Dressage Schooling Show At CEC

All riders are eligible for year-end championship awards. Horse/rider combination must ride in at least two competitions to qualify.

CDS members are also eligible for year-end championship trophies. Horse/rider combination must ride in at least three competitions to qualify. Riders can join CDS at the show.

Proof of current CDS membership is required at the show to be eligible for year-end awards. Please bring your membership card with you or you can join at the show before your class starts.

High point ribbons will be given to the highest scoring senior and junior divisions at the show for Training through FEI. High point prize will be given to the highest scoring test of the day. (Walk/Trot and Musical Freestyle classes are not eligible for high point awards.)

This show is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book. No protective gear (bell/splint boots, polo wraps, etc.) allowed in competition arena. No draw reins or martingales are to be used on show grounds. There will be an EMT present during the show.

ALL RIDERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR HELMETS AND BOOTS. Show jackets and braiding are optional. All tests will be ridden in a 20' x 60' meter arena. Lunging allowed in designated areas only.

All entries close and must be postmarked by **March 13, 2011**. Entries postmarked after the closing date will be subject to a late fee of \$15.00. Scratches made prior to the closing date will be refunded. There will be no refunds after the closing date. All checks returned by the bank will be subject to a \$25 fee.
